- Any passwords and logins provided to members to enable their roles should not be shared with anyone
- All Steering Committee members must complete a Declaration of Interests form and any potential conflicts of interest should be declared at the start of the meeting or as they arise, and, depending on the nature of the conflict, the member concerned should take no part in the discussion
